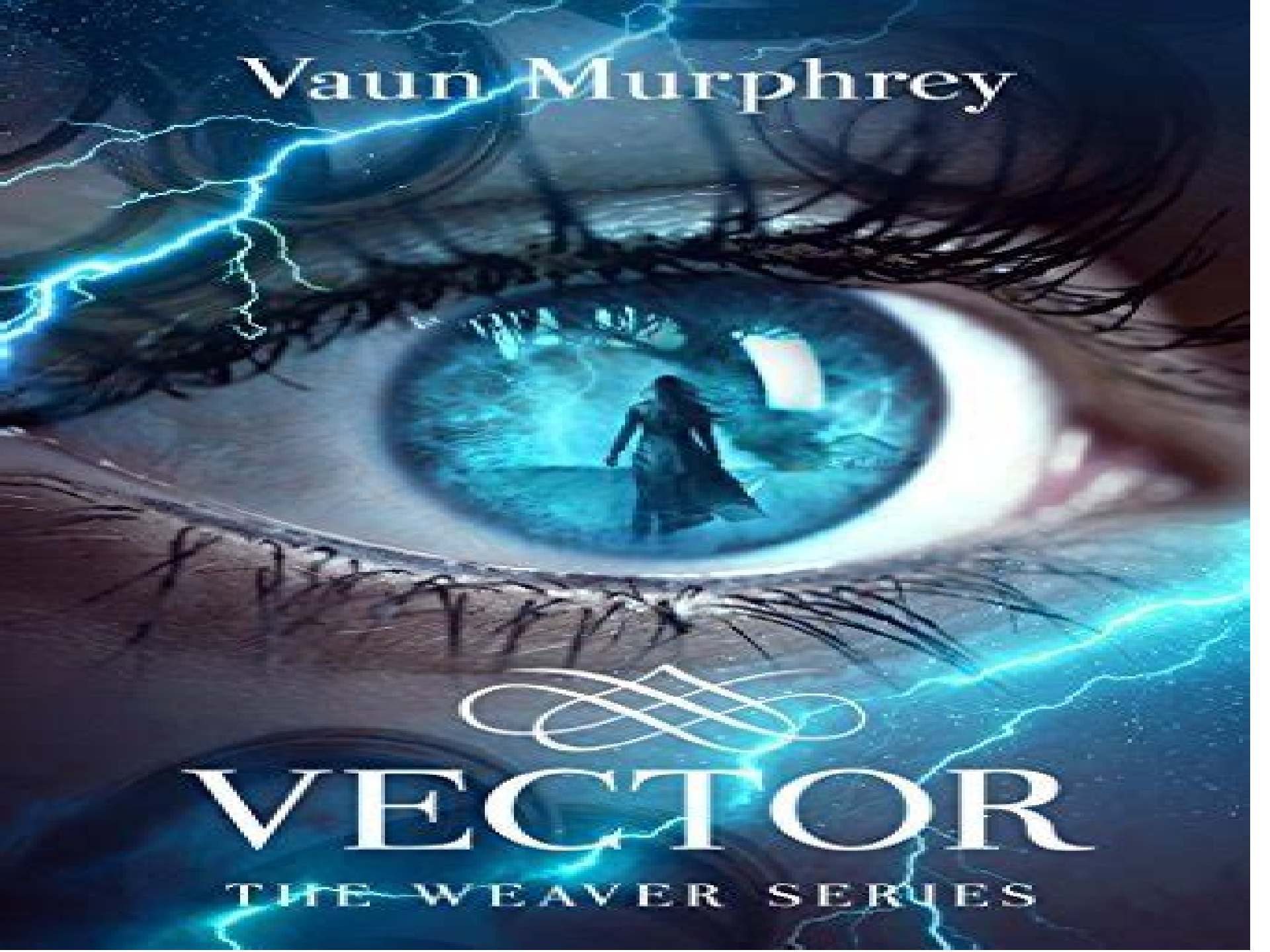

Louis, 2012-12-06 Only one generation ago entomology was a proudly isolated discipline In Comstock Hall the building of the Department of Entomology at Cornell University where I was first introduced to experimental science in the laboratory of Tom Eisner those of us interested in the chemistry of life felt like interlopers In the 35 years that have elapsed since then all of biology has changed and entomology with it Arrogant molecular biologists and resentful classical biologists might think that what has happened is a hostile take over of biology by molecular biology But they are wrong More and more we now understand that the events were happier and much more exciting amounting to a new synthesis Molecular Biology which was initially focused on the simplest of organisms bacteria and viruses broke out of its confines after the initial fundamental questions were answered the structure of DNA the genetic code the nature of regulatory genes and importantly as its methods became more and more generally applicable The recombinant DNA revolution of the 1970s the development of techniques for sequencing macromolecules the polymerase chain reaction new molecular methods of genetic analysis all brought molecular biology face to face with the infinite complexity and the exuberant diversity of life Molecular biology itself stopped being an isolated discipline preoccupied with the universal laws of life and became an approach to addressing fascinating specific problems from every field of biology

Global change and human vulnerability to vector-borne diseases Rubén Bueno-Marí, Ricardo Jiménez-Peydró, It is well known that several climatic environmental and socio demographic changes that have occurred in the last years are some of the most important causes for the emergence resurgence of vector borne diseases worldwide Global change can be defined as the impact of human activity on the fundamental mechanisms of biosphere functioning Therefore global change includes not only climate change but also habitat transformation water cycle modification biodiversity loss synanthropic incursion of alien species into new territories or introduction of new chemicals in nature On this respect some of the effects of global change on vector borne diseases can be currently evaluated Globalization has enabled the movement of parasites viruses and vectors among different countries or even at intercontinental level On this regard it is important to note that the increase of imported malaria cases in different Southern European countries has led to the re appearance of autochthonous cases of disease transmission Moreover the used tire trade together with global warming have facilitated the introduction spread and establishment of potential Dengue tropical vectors such as *Aedes aegypti* or *Aedes albopictus* in temperate areas Consequently recently the first Dengue indigenous cases in the last decades have been reported in different Southern areas of North America and Europe Furthermore habitat modification mainly deforestation and transformation of aquatic environments together with the changes in thermal and rainfall patterns are two of the key factors to explain the increasing incidence of Leishmaniasis and several tick borne diseases The aim of this Research Topic is to cover all related fields with the binomial vector borne diseases global change including basic and applied research approaches to control measures

Approaches to Blocking the Immune Response to Gene Transfer with Viral Vectors

Ertl, Viral vectors are superior tools for gene therapy and as a genetic vaccine platform because viruses have evolved to efficiently infect and transfer their genomes to cells Several impressive successes in viral vector based gene therapies have been reported in humans including restoration of vision in patients with Leber's congenital amaurosis by retinal gene transfer and cures for severe immune deficiencies by gene transfer to hematopoietic stem cells However the mammalian immune system has

evolved in parallel to fend off invading pathogens such as viruses. Innate and antigen specific adaptive immune responses against viral vectors and therapeutic transgene products pose serious hurdles for successful gene therapy. Pre-existing immunity in humans resulting from prior exposure to the parent virus that forms the basis for the gene transfer vehicle may be derived from often prevents efficient gene transfer. This problem also reduces our ability to use certain vectors for genetic vaccination or in anti-cancer therapy. For these reasons the gene transfer community has been extensively studying the mechanisms of immune responses against viral vectors and has started to develop strategies and protocols to block or circumvent such responses. Choice design and engineering of a vector as well as the route of administration, target tissue can be optimized, altered to minimize immune responses or evade pre-existing immunity. Immune suppression and modulation strategies are being developed in order to minimize inflammation, prevent antibody or T cell responses against vectors and to promote tolerance to therapeutic gene products. Combinations of these approaches will likely facilitate clinical applications of gene therapy for many target diseases and also aid in vaccine development. *Emerging Infectious Diseases*, 2004-07
