From the table 1.2 classification interpretation validity coefficient, obtained 20 items in the instrument variable X (method dulohupa) the validity coefficient. From the results of the analysis of 20 instrument items of variable X, 14 valid instrument items and 6 invalid instrument items were obtained. This is because the instrument item is said to be valid if $r_{count} > r_{table}$, and invalid if $r_{count} < r_{table}$.

Validasi bag test results and Y variable (community empowerment)

The category of instrument validity refers to the classification of validity presented by Riyani et al[14] quoted in the UPI Journal on page 6 as well as in the second place classification of the interpretation of the validity coefficient, 10 assessment items were obtained in the variable Y instrument (community empowerment) the coefficient of validity. From the results of the analysis,

obtained 10 items of assessment of community empowerment it is valid, in other words all items are valid. The validity of the validity of the 10 assessment items is declared valid. Because matter or assessment items considered valid if $r_{count} > r_{table}$, and invalid if $r_{count} < r_{table}$.

Validity in Interpretation Eric Donald Hirsch, 1967-01-01 The object of interpretation is textual meaning in and for itself and may be called the meaning of the text The object of criticism on the other hand is that meaning in its bearing on something else standards of value present concerns etc and this object may therefore may be called the significance of the text If textual meaning itself could change contemporary readers would lack a basis for agreement or disagreement No one would bother seriously to discuss such a protean object The interpreter has to distinguish what a text implies from what it does not imply he must give the text its full due but he must also preserve norms and limits For hermeneutic theory the problem is to find a principle for judging whether various possible implications should or should not be admitted By classifying the text as belonging to a particular genre the interpreter automatically posits a general horizon for its meaning The genre provides a sense of the whole a notion of typical meaning components Thus before we interpret a text we often classify it as casual conversation lyric poem military command scientific prose occasional verse novel epic etc The interpreter's job is to specify the text's horizon as far as he is able and this means ultimately that he must familiarize himself with the typical meanings of the author's mental and experiential world Hermeneutics must stress the reconstruction of the author's aims and attitudes in order to evolve guides and norms for construing the meaning of the text Ambiguity or for that matter vagueness is not the same as indeterminateness This is the crux of the issue To say that verbal meaning is determinate is not to exclude complexities of meaning but only to insist that a text's meaning is what it is and not a hundred other things Taken in this sense a vague or ambiguous text is just as determinate as a logical proposition it means what it means and nothing else
