By 1847, nearly the entire United States was owned by the U.S. government. The last piece of land was acquired in 1848 when the U.S. took over the remaining land in the New Mexico Territory after the Mexican American War.

Once the land acquisitions were complete, the United States government had to encourage settlers to move into the frontier territories. Cities were overcrowded, and there was no room for more people. Many people were afraid to move out west. Citizens were not sure if they would be able to make the journey and start new lives in unclaimed territory.

To get people to move, the U.S. government passed the Homestead Act. This act granted free land to any citizen willing to move out west and farm the land for five years. The act allowed only people to build homes and own property when they had never had that option before.
