

URINALYSIS LAB

Purpose

Identify a variety of substances and imbalances in urine that indicate health risks by completing a urinalysis for 6 patients.

Background Info

The kidneys normally filter toxins and waste products out of the blood to be removed from the body, but certain substances can become unbalanced and their presence in urine is a key diagnostic tool for determining potential health risks. Urine color and pH (acidity) can indicate a wide variety of changes in diet or potential disease. The abnormal presence of glucose, proteins, or ketones is indicative of drastic diet changes or health concerns.

The following chart shows the normal ranges for urinalysis as well as a variety of causes for abnormalities. Some causes are acquired through diet, consumption of substances, or health conditions.

Result	Possible Cause	
	Diet/Consumption	Disease
Yellow Color	Normal	None
Clear Color	Increased fluid intake	Uncontrolled diabetes
Orange Color	Cranberry, antibiotics	Jaundice
Green Color	Green food dye, antibiotics	Bacterial infection
Red/Brown Color	Berries, anti-inflammatory drugs	Kidney failure (blood), kidney stones (blood), liver disease or muscle injury
Low pH (<6)	High protein diet	Uncontrolled diabetes
5-8 pH	Normal	None
High pH (>8)	High vegetable and dairy diet	Anemia
Glucose Present	Large carbohydrate meal	Diabetes
Protein Present	Large protein meal	Anemia, muscle injury
Ketones Present	Low carbohydrate diet	Ketosis
