
Creating a Timeline



What did you do yesterday? When you are thinking about the events of yesterday, most likely you start with waking up and then going to bed and everything in between. You did things in order. The events in history can also be written down in order from the beginning of time until today.

One of the best ways to show events in time is by using a timeline. A timeline is a graph showing the passage of time on a straight line. It can be horizontal (across) or vertical (up and down).





Things to remember when making a timeline:

- A timeline can be created using years, months, days, or even hours as the time periods.
- They can contain images, pictures, or other drawings related to the events.
- A timeline can start and end at any time, or show one year, one month, or one day in history.
- Timelines can be about a person's life, events in history, inventions, or just about anything that shows information during the passage of time.
- The spaces between time periods should match the time.
 For example, notice the timeline above shows every 10 years, except there is a larger gap or interval between 1975 and 1995 because 20 years have passed.
