The final section explores the relations between human life and the nature of the sea as a material mobile and more than human space examining the

influences of the ocean on the migratory practices of fishermen in Senegal to the more than human geographies of the contemporary scallop industry the historical journeys of steam ship companies and the pirate radio enterprise Oceans are fundamental to the workings of the world as we know it Critical human activities take place at sea including trade tourism migration scientific exploration and resource exploitation The water world is therefore significantly entwined with our everyday lives This book offers a novel and important contribution to an ever emerging cross disciplinary subject matter
