literacy education to date this book seeks to address this gap by taking stock of illustrative initiatives promoting budget literacy for youth in selected countries The underlying presumption is that when supply side actors in the budget process governments simplify and disseminate budget information for demand side actors citizens this information will then be used by citizens to provide feedback on the budget However since citizens are often insufficiently informed about public budgets to constructively participate in budget processes one way to empower them and to remedy the problem of budget illiteracy is to provide budget literacy education in schools to youth helping them evolve into civic minded adults with the essential knowledge needed for analyzing their government s fiscal policy objectives and measures and the confidence and sense of social responsibility to participate in the oversight of public resources This book elaborates on approaches learning outcomes pedagogical strategies and assessment approaches for budget literacy education and presents lessons that are relevant for the development improvement or scaling up of budget literacy initiatives
