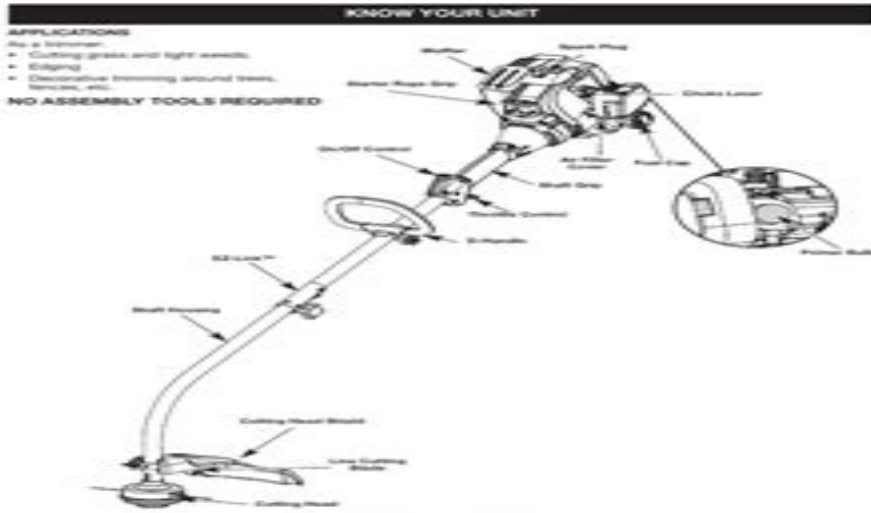

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

INSTALL CUTTING ATTACHMENT SHIELD

WARNING: To prevent serious personal injury, never operate the trimmer without the cutting attachment shield in place.

Use the following instructions if the cutting attachment shield is not installed. Use only the instructions that apply to the type unit and shield that the unit is equipped with.

- Place the cutting attachment shield onto the shaft housing. Be sure the guard mounting bracket slides into the slot on the edge of the cutting shield. Place the shield into place, counter-clockwise (Fig. 1). The holes in the guard mounting bracket and cutting attachment shield will line up.
- From inside the cutting attachment shield, push the release bolt through the hole until the threaded end protrudes through the guard mounting bracket (Fig. 2).

- Put the washer on the bolt; then screw the wing nut onto the bolt and tighten.
- Insert the D-handle down onto the shaft housing (Fig. 3). The hex bolt hole in the handle should be on the left side.
- Insert the D-handle into the hole in the handle and push through. Place the washer on the bolt; then screw the wing nut onto the bolt. Do not tighten until making the handle adjustment.
- Rotate the D-handle to the grip above the top of the shaft housing. Place it a minimum of 6 inches (15.24 cm) from the end of the shaft grip.
- While holding the unit in the operating position (Fig. 10), move the D-handle to the location that provides the best grip.

Tighten the wing nut until the D-handle is secure.

REMOVING THE ADD-ON

- Turn the knob counter-clockwise to loosen (Fig. 4).
- Press and hold the release button (Fig. 4).
- While slowly holding the upper shaft housing, pull the lower shaft housing straight out of the EZ-LINK™ coupler (Fig. 5).

INSTALLING THE ADD-ON

NOTE: To make installing or removing the add-on easier, place the unit on the ground or on a work bench.

- Turn knob counter-clockwise to loosen (Fig. 4).
- Press and hold the release button with it straight into the EZ-LINK™ coupler (Fig. 5).

NOTE: Aligning the release button with the guide recess will help installation (Fig. 4).

- Turn the knob clockwise to tighten (Fig. 4).
- For decorative trimming/edging with the **See cutting head**, lock the release button into the "0" hole (Fig. 4).

OIL AND FUEL MIXING INFORMATION

OIL AND FUEL MIXING INSTRUCTIONS: Oil and fuel properly mixed fuel are the most important factors for the proper fuel running properly. Be sure to use fresh, clean, unleaded fuel. Follow the instructions carefully for the proper fuel mixture.

DEFINITION OF BLENDED FUELS

WARNING: It has been proven that fuel containing greater than 10% ethanol will likely damage this engine and void the warranty.

Today's fuels are often a blend of gasoline and oxygenates such as ethanol, methanol, or MTBE (ether). Alcohol-blended fuels (also called E-10, E-15, or E-20) contain 10%, 15%, or 20% alcohol by volume. If you are using alcohol-blended fuel, use fresh fuel (less than 30 days old).

IF choosing to use a blended fuel, or its use is unavoidable, follow recommended precautions:

- Always use the fresh fuel mix explained in the operator's manual.
- Use the fuel additive STA-BIL® or an equivalent.

OIL AND FUEL INFORMATION

- Always add the fuel mix before turning the unit.
- Drain the tank and run the engine dry before storing the unit.

USING FUEL ADDITIVES

CAUTION: For proper engine operation and maximum life, always add oil and fuel mix according to the instructions on the 2-cycle oil container. Using improperly mixed fuel can severely damage the engine.

The bottle of 2-cycle oil contains a fuel additive which will help inhibit corrosion and enhance the lubrication of your equipment. It is recommended to use just 2-cycle oil with this unit.

If available, use a good 2-cycle oil designed for air-cooled engines along with a fuel stabilizer or an equivalent. Add 0.9 fl. oz. (27 ml) of fuel additive per gallon of fuel according to the instructions on the 2-cycle oil container. Add 1.0 fl. oz. (29 ml) of fuel additive per gallon of fuel according to the instructions on the 2-cycle oil container.

Thoroughly mix the proper ratio of 2-cycle engine oil with unleaded fuel in a separate fuel can. Use a 40:1 fuel-to-oil ratio. Do not mix them directly in the engine fuel tank. See the table for specific gas and oil mixing ratios.

NOTE: One gallon (128 fl. oz.) of unleaded gasoline (92 octane) will mix with 3.2 fl. oz. (95 ml) of 2-cycle oil to make a 40:1 fuel-to-oil ratio.

NOTE: Choose the oil fuel-to-oil mix in accordance to fuel-to-oil ratio and fuel-to-oil ratio.

WARNING: Gasoline is extremely flammable. Ignited vapors may explode. Always add the engine oil and allow it to cool before filling the fuel tank. Do not smoke while filling the tank. Keep sparks and open flames at a distance from the area.

FUELING THE UNIT

- The cutting head is parallel to the ground and easily contacts the grass without the need to bend over.

ADJUSTING THE CUTTING LINE LENGTH

WARNING: Adjust the cutting line length after the line cutting head assembly. Excessive line length will cause premature engine failure and/or unit damage.
