More broadly, it radically questioned the socio-political dispensation resulting from the 1994 social pact between big business, the ruling elite and the liberation movement. The 2015 revolt links to national and international youth struggles of the recent past and is informed by black consciousness politics and social movements of the international left. The student movement has challenged the hierarchical top-down leadership system of university management and its double speak of professing to act in workers and students' interests yet entrenching a regressive system for control and governance.
