

stigma and discrimination Elsewhere organisation capacity is implied such as medical resources for withdrawal management where recommendations indicate use of medications As all forms of treatment will not be readily available or suitable for all populations or settings these guidelines may require interpretation and adaptation *Australian national bibliography* ,1961
