"the process by which societies move from traditional or pre-modern conditions to those of modernity, characterized by industrialisation, urbanisation, and the growth of a mass society." (2005)

Rationalization

Rationalization is the replacement of traditional motivators of actions (religious beliefs, traditions, etc.) with pure logic and the scientific method.

Urbanization

Urbanization is a process of population movement from rural areas to cities. It leads to a more diversified and industrialized economy.
