Having finished a Ph.D. with Dr. William W. Mohn at the University of British Columbia in early 2005, I am currently a Postdoctoral Research Fellow at the University of Warwick under the direction of Professor J. Colin Murrell.

My research focuses on the factors affecting the diversity and composition of microbial communities, and also on the discovery of novel organisms and metabolic functions that mediate carbon and nitrogen transformations in the environment. A solid familiarity with molecular and genomic techniques, as well as extensive experience with soil and aquatic environments suggest a good fit for me as a faculty member within the Department of Biology at the University of Waterloo.

The position description indicates the importance of active research and teaching for the candidate. As the attached curriculum vitae shows, my love for research in environmental microbiology and ability to communicate effectively have resulted in numerous publications and award-winning presentations. 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Benford's Law Mark J. Nigrini, 2012-03-09 A powerful new tool for all forensic accountants or anyone who analyzes data that may have been altered Benford's Law gives the expected patterns of the digits in the numbers in tabulated data such as town and city populations or Madoff's fictitious portfolio returns Those digits in unaltered data will not occur in equal proportions there is a large bias towards the lower digits so much so that nearly one half of all numbers are expected to start with the digits 1 or 2 These patterns were originally discovered by physicist Frank Benford in the early 1930s and have since been found to apply to all tabulated data Mark J Nigrini has been a pioneer in applying Benford's Law to auditing and forensic accounting even before his groundbreaking 1999 Journal of Accountancy article introducing this useful tool to the accounting world In Benford's Law Nigrini shows the widespread applicability of Benford's Law and its practical uses to detect fraud errors and other anomalies Explores primary associated and advanced tests all described with data sets that include corporate payments data and election data Includes ten fraud detection studies including vendor fraud payroll fraud due diligence when purchasing a business and tax evasion Covers financial statement fraud with data from Enron AIG and companies that were the target of hedge fund short sales Looks at how to detect Ponzi schemes including data on Madoff Waxenberg and more Examines many other applications from the Clinton tax returns and the charitable gifts of Lehman Brothers to tax evasion and number invention Benford's Law has 250 figures and uses 50 interesting authentic and fraudulent real world data sets to explain both theory and practice and concludes with an agenda and directions for future research The companion website adds additional information and resources
