Ballard, 1990 When the Atrocity Exhibition was originally printed 1970 Nelson Doubleday saw a copy and was so horrified he ordered the entire press run shredded Two years later Grove Press brought out a small hardback printing re titled Love and Napalm Export USA Now Re Search brings out an illustrated large format edition of this notorious work augmented with four recently written stories plus extensive annotations written by the author never before published which clarify and illuminate this exhilarating prophetic masterpiece Book jacket [The Atrocity Exhibition](#) J.
