



STANFORD-BINET SCALE

- Dr. Lewis Terman adapted the Binet-Simon Test for students in America in collaboration with Stanford University and renamed it as Stanford-Binet Scale.
- While Terman employed many tests from Binet's scale, he incorporated new tests based on his own methodical research, which provided a better representation of population and included higher and lower age range.
- The most important aspect of Terman's revision was incorporating William Stern's concept of intelligence quotient (IQ). IQ was defined as the ratio of mental age to chronological age multiplied by 100. The concept of IQ replaced Binet's "mental age."
- Children whose Mental Age equal their Chronological Age were considered to be of "Regular Intelligence."
