major challenge The key lesson for policymakers is that even in the context of overall economic improvement food insecurity remains endemic among the poorest segments of the urban population Households are already accustomed to drawing on resources outside of the formal economy and improvements in employment income have not reversed that trend These alternative livelihood strategies should therefore be considered as a normal part of urban life and supported with state resources that can improve access to food for the most marginalized groups
