This volume represents a major critique of the way Malthusian thinking has influenced capitalist development policy in the modern period as well as in the past. It highlights the strategic role of Malthusian ideas in the defence of capitalist political economy when confronted by struggles for equality and human progress. The leading historical example the author takes offers a major reassessment of the origins of the Irish Famine. His contemporary case study focuses on the Green Revolution which the author analyzes in terms of a broad Western strategy of capitalist agricultural development in the face of peasant insurgency. Finally the book examines how the political economy of underdevelopment is currently being obscured by alarm over the environmental impact of over population and how such Malthusian concerns represent the poor not as victims of capitalist development but as perpetrators of environmental destruction.

The Invention of Scarcity Deborah Valenze, 2023-01-01 A radical new reading of eighteenth century British theorist Thomas Robert Malthus which recovers diverse ideas about subsistence production and environments later eclipsed by classical economics. With the publication of *Essay on the Principle of Population* and its projection of food shortages in the face of ballooning populations British theorist Thomas Robert Malthus secured a leading role in modern political and economic thought. In this startling new interpretation Deborah Valenze reveals how canonical readings of Malthus fail to acknowledge his narrow understanding of what constitutes food production. Valenze returns to the eighteenth century contexts that generated his arguments showing how Malthus mobilized a redemptive narrative of British historical development and dismissed the varied ways that people adapted to the challenges of subsistence needs. She uses history anthropology food studies and animal studies to redirect our attention to the margins of Malthus's essay where activities such as hunting gathering herding and gardening were rendered extraneous. She demonstrates how Malthus's omissions and his subsequent canonization provided a rationale for colonial imposition of British agricultural models regardless of environmental diversity. By broadening our conception of human livelihoods Valenze suggests pathways to resistance against the hegemony of Malthusian political economy. *The Invention of Scarcity* invites us to imagine a world where monoculture is in retreat and the margins are recentered as spaces of experimentation nimbleness and human flourishing.

The Popularization of Malthus in Early Nineteenth-Century

England James P. Huzel, 2017-05-15 The political economist Thomas Robert Malthus 1766 1834 has gained increasing and deserved scholarly attention in recent years As well as the republication of his works and letters a rich body of scholarship has been produced that enlightens our understanding of his thoughts and arguments Yet little has been written on the ways in which his message was translated to and interpreted by a popular audience Malthus first rose to prominence in 1798 with the publication of his *Essay on the Principle of Population* in which he blamed rising levels of poverty on the inability of Britain's economy to support its growing population His remedy to limit the number of children born to poor families outraged many social reformers most notably William Cobbett but found a ready audience in other quarters Harriet Martineau among others being a famous Malthusian advocate In this new study of Malthus and the impact of his writings James Huzel shows how by being both popularized and demonized he framed the terms of reference for debate on the problems of pauperism and became the beacon against which all proposals seeking to remedy the problem of poverty had to be measured It is argued that the New Poor Law of 1834 was deeply influenced by Malthusian ideals replacing the traditional sources of outdoor relief with the humiliation of the workhouse Dealing with issues of social economic and intellectual history this work offers a fresh and insightful investigation into one of the most influential though misunderstood thinkers of the late eighteenth and early nineteenth centuries and concludes that Malthus was perhaps even more important than Adam Smith and David Ricardo in fostering the rise of a market economy It is essential reading for all those who wish to reach a fuller understanding of how the tremendous social and economic upheavals of the Industrial Revolution shaped the development of modern Britain
