that could monitor the tiny quantities of sodium and potassium found in solutions They decided to give this device the name Flame photometer When a metal is added to a flame the flame photometer works by measuring the change in the amount of light that is released as a result of the addition of the metal The color of the flame provides information about the concentration of the element in the sample while the wavelength of the color provides information about the element itself One of the subfields that falls under the umbrella of atomic absorption spectroscopy is called flame photometry Flame emission spectroscopy is another name for this technique The area of analytical chemistry now considers it an essential piece of equipment to have at their disposal The concentration of various metal ions such as sodium potassium lithium calcium and cesium among others may be ascertained with the use of a flame photometer Spectra obtained from flame photometers employ metal ions represented as atoms rather than their usual form This method is referred to as flame atomic emission spectrometry and it was given that title by the Committee on Spectroscopic Nomenclature of the International Union of Pure and Applied Chemistry IUPAC FAES
