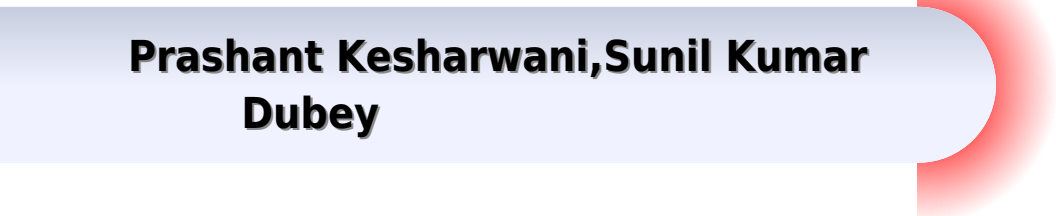


Preparing for the BCOP Exam
