plane The tool trajectories generated by those algorithms are dependent on a range of input parameters as well as a computer generated model that approximates a part or feature that needs to be machined all supplied by the user of the software The main goal of such algorithms is to create a specific pattern of tool motion that produces a desired finish on the part without gouging the work ie removing too much material where not intended or leaving too much excess material Typically the tool trajectory generation approaches do not take into consideration the kinematic capabilities and limitations of a CNC machine in order to generate time efficient tool trajectories. This is due in part to the sheer number of different types of machines available on the market each with its own set of unique specifications. In addition to that the problem of generating a specific pattern of motion that is at the same time optimized for another parameter such as machining time is of great complexity Usually the motion pattern is the most important factor in trajectory generation and machining time reduction is in most cases limited to real time feed rate speed optimization by the CNC machine processor at machining execution without any trajectory modifications.
