

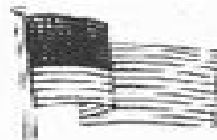

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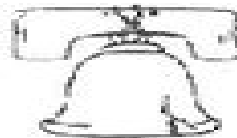

Kierkegaard Word of God and Word of Man 206 John Updike stated that the purpose of his writing novels and stories is to examine everything for God's fingerprints. In the 1960s when he started writing his name was associated with other writers such as John Barth, Robert Coover and Thomas Pynchon busy in experimenting new themes and strategies Updike ignored the main stream of contemporary fiction and distanced himself from the contemporary writers. His mission was to write a new kind of fiction to create a new kind of world to depict the new future of mankind the way Karl Marx had done.
