'Men of the German Reichstag! France has replied to the repeated friendly offers and peaceful assurances made by Germany by infringing on the Rhine Pact through a military alliance with the Soviet Union, exclusively directed against Germany.' As Stackelberg and Winkle note, this encouraged sympathy amongst conservatives abroad who considered Communism a threat to the stability of Europe. They were more worried by the Soviet Union than German fascism. It also broke down Holland and Belgium's willingness to coordinate defensive strategy for fear of inevitable conflict – by showing Germany's strength, others became unwilling. This was Hitler's aim?

P. 195: Contextual information on Germany in 1936 at home:

The Four-Year Plan – Hitler cautioned by the central Reich Bank Hjamir Schact (also his Economics Minister) that excessive deficit financing was damaging and proposed integration into the world markets. Hitler refused to slow rearmament for simple economic reasons.
