DURING the dread reign of the Cholera in New York, I had accepted the invitation of a relative to spend a fortnight with him in the retirement of his cottage orner on the banks of the Hudson. We had here around us all the ordinary means of summer amusement, and what with rambling in the woods, sketching, bosting, fishing, bathing, music, and books, we should have passed the time pleasantly enough, but for the fearful intelligence which reached us every morning from the populous outs. Not a day elapsed which did not bring us news of the decease of some acquaintance. Then as the fatality increased, we learned to expect daily the loss of some fixend. At length we trembled at the approach of every messenger. The very air from the South seemed to us redolent with death. That palitying thought, indeed, took entire poression of my soul. I could neither meak think, nor dream of any thing else. My host was of a less excitable temperament, and, although greatly depressed in spirits, exerted himself to sustain my own. His righly philosophical intellect was not at any time affected by unrealities. To the substances of terror he was sufficiently alive, but of its shadows he had no apprehention

His endeavors to arouse me from the condition of abnormal gloom into which I had follow, were frustrated, in great measure, by certain volumes which I had found in his library. These were of a character to force into germination whatever seeds of hereditary superstation lay latent in my bosom. I had been reading these books without his knowledge, and thus he was often at a loss to account for the forceble impressions which had been made upon my fancy.

A far orite topic with me was the popular belief in omens- a belief which, at this one epoch of my life, I was almost sensually disposed to defend. On this subject we had long and animated discussions- he maintaining the utter groundlessness of faith in such matters. I contending that a popular sentiment arising with absolute spontaneity- that is to say, without apparent traces of suggestion- had in itself the unmistakable elements of truth, and was entitled to as much respect as that intuition which is the idio synorasy of the individual man of genius.

The fact is, that soon after my arrival at the cottage there had occurred to myrelf an incident so entirely inexplicable, and which had in it so much of the portentous character, that I might well have been excused for regarding it as an occur. It appalled, and at the same time so confounded and
