
Statue of Liberty

Origins of Lady Liberty

The Statue of Liberty's official name is "Liberty Enlightening the World", and it is sometimes called **Lady Liberty** or **Mother of Exiles**. An **exile** may be a refugee or a person who has left another country because of danger and in search of freedom.

The designer of the statue was a French sculptor, Frederic Bartholdi.

He also helped raise money to build it and picked the New York Harbor for its display. The original idea, though, for the statue came from a French anti-slavery activist **Edouard de Laboulaye**. The interior of the statue was built by **Gustave**

Eiffel. He is the same person who later built the Eiffel Tower, which is a symbol that represents the country of France.

The Statue of Liberty was a gift from France, announced in 1875, and was officially given to the United States in 1886 during the celebration of America's 100th birthday. It took several years for the statue to be constructed. It was built in pieces. In 1876, the arm and torch were built and then displayed in Philadelphia. Next, the head was built and put on display in 1878 at the World's Fair in Paris, France.
