Open or Closed

Open: open to air with topical antimicrobial - often limited to facial burns Closed:topical antimicrobial and area covered with sterile dressing



Debridement

Removal of necrotic tissue





Positioning

No cushions (especially if you have neck/ear burns); roll a cloth under your shoulders



Pain relievers

Use pain relievers before dressing changes or debridement!



Elevation

Elevate the extremities to avoid edema and contractures
