- **Joseph Stalin**
 - One of Lenin's revolutionary supporters
 - Lenin feared Stalin's increasing amount of power
 - Was cold, hard, and impersonal
- **Totalitarianism**
 - When a government takes total, centralized state control over every aspect of public and private life
- **Command economy**
 - A system in which the government makes all economic decisions
- **Collective farm**
 - In 1928, the government began to seize over 25 million privately owned farms in the USSR, and combined them into large, government-owned farms
 - Hundreds of families worked on these farms, producing food for the state
- **Kulak**
 - Class of wealthy peasants
 - Resisted strongly against Stalin/Stalin's Agricultural Revolution
 - Many were executed or sent to work camps
- **Great Purge**
 - In 1934, Stalin turned against the members of the Communist Party, and launched the Great Purge, which was a campaign of terror
 - It was directed at anyone who threatened Stalin's power
 - Thousands of old Bolsheviks who helped stage the revolution stood trial for "crimes against the Soviet state"
 - The state had the authority to punish even the most minor acts
- **Socialist realism**
 - An artistic style that praised Soviet life and Communist values
