Layers of the Skin:

- Epidermis: Outermost later (first-line of defense) THICKEST on palms and soles of feet contains keratinocytes, melanocytes, merkel, langerhaus, and inflammatory cells.
- Dermis: Second layer has two 1) Papillary (superficial & directly connected to epidermis made of loose conn.
 Tissue, elastin, capillaries, blood vessels, and nerves) and 2) Reticular (deeper layer made of collagen and elastin for resilience, elasticity, and turgor of skin).
- Subcutaneous (fatty): composed of loose connective tissue and fat for insulation functions: storage of coloric reserves, cushforing, & mobility.

- Immunologic
- Absorption
- Ellimination

Associated Structures of Skin:

- Hair: functinos for debris, invasion, insulation, sensory stimuli, and gender ID 2 Types: 1) veitus (on arms/all over body) and terminal (scalp, armpits, eyebrows, etc.)
- Nails
- Glands: 3 types ecorine (sweat), apportise (sweat + body odor), and sebaceous (oil that leads to pose).

Assessing for Dehydration - Older Adults

- → Loss of collagen = dehydration
- → Skin turger on Inner thigh
- → Sunken eyes, dry oral mucosa, and dry axilla

Risk factors for Integumentary Disorders: debydration, cyanosis, impaired skin integrity, or infections

Requires IMMEDIATE attention: Large wounds and burns!
