Prehistoric Art - Answer-the beginning of art, the first art objects were created to control natural forces. Highly focused on symbols of animals and people that had supernatural significance and magic powers.

Sculptures in the Prehistoric Era: - Answer-made from bone, ivory, stone, or antlers. These were either engraved, carved in deep relief, or fully rounded three dimensional sculptures.

Venus of Willendorf - Answer-earliest known human figures, a fertility fetish, symbolizing abundance.

Cave Painting - Answer-in the prehistoric era, pictures of bison, deer, horses, cattle, mammoths, and boars were painted in the hope of a successful hunt. Many are portrayed with arrows. The paints they used were chunks of red and yellow ochre ground into powder and applied with brushes or blown onto the surface through hollow bones.

Horse (cave painting) - Answer-to create these images, cave artists used charcoal to outline irregularities of cave walls that suggest forms from nature. Tonal shading with earth-tone pigments lent contour and perspective. No backgrounds, and seemed to float in space.

Paleolithic Era - Answer-called the old stone age (from 10,000 to 2.5 million years ago); they were concerned with food supply; they used stone as well as bone tools; they were nomadic hunters and gatherers.

Neolithic Era - Answer-the New Stone Age; the time period after the Paleolithic Era, marked by the use of tools

Dolmen - Answer-consisting of large vertical stones with a covering slab like a giant table

Menhir - Answer-or single stone set on its end

Cromlech - Answer-circular arrangement of stones, such as stonehenge

Stonehenge - Answer-a structure found by scientist in England is believed to have been built in the Neolithic Age and Bronze Age. Believed to be either the creation of an
