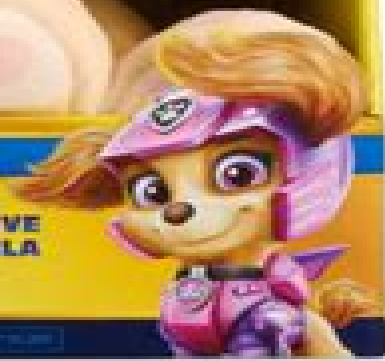

The Klamath tribe saw it happen and passed down the story for nearly 8 000 years. We however have been literate so long that we've forgotten how myths encode reality. Recent studies of how our brains work applied to a wide range of data from the Pacific Northwest to ancient Egypt to modern stories reported in newspapers have helped the Barbers deduce the characteristic principles by which such tales both develop and degrade through time. Myth is in fact a quite reasonable way to convey important messages orally over many generations although reasoning back to the original events is possible only under rather specific conditions. Our oldest written records date to 5 200 years ago but we have been speaking and mythmaking for perhaps 100 000. This groundbreaking book points the way to restoring some of that lost history and teaching us about human storytelling.

Ana is eleven when the Soviet soldiers send her from Bucovina, Romania to Kazakhstan. She is just one of many forced to leave behind her home and make the three-week-long journey via train. The trip is a harsh, humiliating one but in spite of the cold and the closeness of death, life persists in the boxcar in the form of storytelling, riddles and ritual. Years later Ana recalls her childhood for her great granddaughter who is considering moving her to a nursing home. Her story told with unflinching candor is a chronicle of a life lived during a time of great political and national change, a story of an existence defined and curtailed by lines drawn on a map. The narration is interspersed with songs that transform into poems and prayers spoken in the past that become prayers in the present. What links the narration is not so much a plot as it is the reader's astonishment. How could Ana survive such a series of experiences and do so with her mind and heart intact? A history of cruelty and trauma lies behind the banal markers of contemporary life. These realizations combine in the central theme of the book, one which the narrator describes as stories bring you youth.

had ennobled the Montgolfier family in recognition of the brothers important achievements which perhaps prompted a royal celebration for the animals like the one depicted in the book In Gibert s fantasy the animals anger the king at the fete by describing him as no bigger than the tiniest snail when viewed from high above the ground and Louis imprisons them in the Bastille While the direct role of talking animals in the storming of the Bastille in 1789 can t quite be supported by historical evidence this book does vividly evoke the stirring developments in aeronautics that took place right around the time of the French Revolution Ages five to seven

Comet in Our Sky Poh Soo Kai, Singapore s political firmament is crowded with stars who could have lit up to the island state s history but were snuffed out by detention and harassment before they could do so One of the brightest was probably Lim Chin Siong who with Lee Kuan Yew was one of the founders of the People s Action Party but he spent more time in detention than representing his constituents Lim Chin Siong was the most prominent left wing leader in Singapore for a decade until he was eliminated from the political scene by the infamous Operation Coldstore on February 2 1963 This book is an account of Lim s significance in Singapore s political developments in the decade preceding It also contains tributes by his friends and colleagues in Singapore and Malaysia an assessment of his life by many who were inspired by him This new edition features an essay by Dr Poh Soo Kai and an extract from Lim s posthumous manuscripts

Between Sky and Sea Herz Bergner, 2010-06-07 A group of Jewish refugees are thrown together on board a dilapidated freighter charting a course for Australia Fleeing terrible scenes of destruction in Europe they are bound by a deep sense of loss and the uncertainty of their fate As the ship lists inner conflicts burst to the surface and romance revenge guilt and desperation fill the craft There s poignancy drama and an abiding strength of humanity as the passengers lives play out in this unbearable hinterland between sky and sea Now more than sixty years since its publication in 1946 *Between Sky and Sea* has been resurrected to take its place among Australia s major works of diaspora fiction Arnold Zable s introduction highlights the chilling parallels between Bergner s tale and the sinking of the SIEV X off the Australian coast giving the reader pause to reflect on the unchanging plight of asylum seekers throughout history and across the globe Herz Bergner was born in Poland in 1907 and migrated to Australia with his wife in 1938 His first book *The New House* published in 1941 was a collection of short stories about immigrants adapting to life in a new land Herz Bergner died in 1970 This novel resurrected from its foreign country of the past might stand as an epitaph for the 353 men women and children drowned in 2001 when the SIEV X sank while trying to reach Australia At the very least *Between Sky and Sea* should be required reading for refugee policymakers today Canberra Times Beautifully written with extraordinary insight into the frailties of humanity Bergner s tale is as much a version of the past as it is a vision of our present We can only hope that publishers such as Text continue to salvage the treasury of migrant literature that is no longer in print Australian Bergner s astute observation of life shows in his sharp psychological dissection of this human cargo and his unflinching assessment of people s flaws Bergner writes with such compassion that a reader becomes infected by his characters yearnings Herald Sun There s
