

Addiction Simulation

In this interactive classroom simulation, students step into the roles of the brain, neural pathways, mover (body), and dopamine to physically act out how addiction develops over time.

In **Round 1**, the brain writes a message and sends it through the neural pathway to the mover, who performs the action. Dopamine rewards the brain with high fives, reinforcing the habit. Students have 4 min to collect dopamine.

But in **Round 2**, addiction takes hold, the brain starts craving more dopamine (more high fives), while less dopamine is actually released. The neural pathway speeds up, students start skipping steps, and soon, the brain is no longer in control—the action is happening almost automatically. It's chaos and it's fun.. but then you anchor it home with a powerful message about the dangers of no longer being in control.
