Living Martyrs in Late Antiquity and Beyond Diane Fruchtman, 2023-02-01 This book demonstrates that living martyrdom was an important spiritual aspiration in the late antique Latin west and argues that consequently attempts to define study or locate martyrdom must move away from conceptualizations that require or center on death. After an introduction that traces the persistence of living martyrs as real objects of spiritual devotion and emulation across the span of Christian history and discusses why such martyrs have been overlooked, the book focuses on three significant authors from the late ancient Latin west for whom martyrdom did not require death: the Spanish poet Prudentius c. 348-413, the senator-turned-ascetic Paulinus of Nola 353-431, and the influential North African bishop Augustine of Hippo 354-430. Through historically and literarily contextualized close readings of their work, this book shows that each of these three authors attempted to create a new paradigm of martyrdom focused on living rather than dying for God. By focusing on these living martyrs, we are able to see more clearly the aspirations and agendas of those who promoted them as martyrs and how their martyrological discourse illuminates the variety of ways that martyrdom is and can be mobilized in any era to construct new community-creating worldviews. *Living Martyrs in Late Antiquity and Beyond* is an important resource for historians of Christianity, scholars of religious studies, and anyone interested in exploring or understanding martyrological discourse. Recognizing Miracles in Antiquity and Beyond Maria Gerolemou, 2018-04-23 In recent years scholars have extensively explored the function of the miraculous and wondrous in ancient narratives mostly pondering on how ancient authors view wondrous accounts i.e. the treatment of the descriptions of wondrous occurrences as true events or their use More precisely these narratives investigate whether the wondrous pursues a display of erudition or merely provides stylistic variety sometimes such narratives even represent the wish of the author to grant a rational explanation to extraordinary actions At present however two aspects of the topic have not been fully examined a) the ability of the wondrous miraculous to set cognitive mechanisms in motion and b) the power of the wondrous miraculous to contribute to the construction of an authorial identity that of kings gods or narrators To this extent the volume approaches miracles and wonders as counter intuitive phenomena beyond cognitive grasp which challenge the authenticity of human experience and knowledge and push forward the frontiers of intellectual and aesthetic experience Some of the articles of the volume examine miracles on the basis of bewilderment that could lead to new factual knowledge the supernatural is here registered as something natural although strange the rest of the articles treat miracles as an endpoint where human knowledge stops and the unknown divine begins here the supernatural is confirmed Thence questions like whether the experience of a miracle or wonder as a counter intuitive phenomenon could be part of long term memory i.e. if miracles could be transformed into solid knowledge and what mental functions are encompassed in this process are central in the discussion

The Poems of Browning: Volume Three John Woolford, Daniel Karlin, Joseph Phelan, 2014-04-08

The Poems of Browning is a multi-volume edition of the poetry of Robert Browning (1812-1889) resulting from a completely fresh appraisal of the canon, text and context of his work. The poems are presented in the order of their composition and in the text in which they were first published, giving a unique insight into the origins and development of Browning's art. Annotations and headnotes, in keeping with the traditions of Longman Annotated English Poets, are full and informative and provide details of composition, publication sources and contemporary reception. Volumes one (1826-1840) and two (1841-1846) presented the poems from his early years up to his marriage to Elizabeth Barrett, including the dramatic poem *Paracelsus* (1835) which first brought him to wide attention and *Sordello* (1840) which confirmed him as a poet of ambition and imagination. Volume three (1847-1861) of *The Poems of Browning* covers the years of Browning's life in Italy with his wife Elizabeth Barrett Browning. During the fifteen years of his marriage and self-imposed exile, Browning produced *Christmas Eve and Easter Day* (1850), a major statement of his religious philosophy and *Men and Women* (1855), his greatest collection of shorter poems. The poems of *Men and Women*, like all Browning's work, are steeped in his wide and idiosyncratic knowledge of literature, music, art, history and popular culture, but a new and distinctive touch comes from the sights, sounds and textures of ordinary life in Italy. Based on a comprehensive study of textual and contextual sources, including a significant amount of hitherto undiscovered or unpublished manuscripts of poems and letters, this volume offers the most complete and informative edition of works that are central to Browning's achievement. In addition, Browning's most important work of critical prose, the *Essay on Shelley*, is presented in an appendix with full annotation, and poems which refer to specific works of painting or sculpture are illustrated with colour plates. Volume four presents the poetry Browning produced during the decade following the death of his wife, including *Dramatis Personae*, which heralded a re-evaluation of his critical reputation and *The Ring and the Book*, which many
