

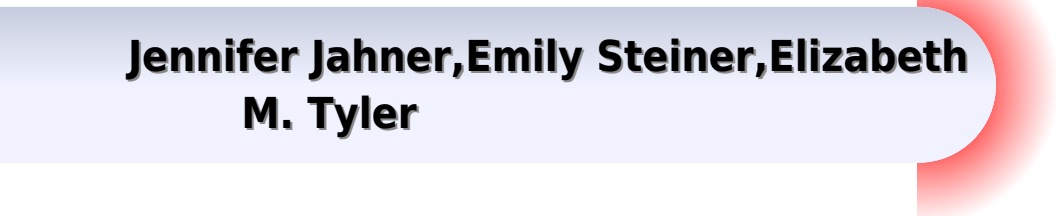

BOOK JACKET *The Trafalgar Chronicle: New Series 2* Peter Hore, 2017-11-30 The Trafalgar Chronicle the yearbook of The 1805 Club has established itself as a prime source of information and the publication of choice for new research about the Georgian navy sometimes also loosely called Nelson's navy Successive editors have widened the scope to include all sailing navies of the period while a recurring theme is the Trafalgar campaign and the epic battle of 21 October 1805 Contributors to The Trafalgar Chronicle have included leading experts in their field whether they are Professor John Hattendorf from the US Naval War College in Newport RI Professor Andrew Lambert from Kings College London or antiquarians and enthusiasts Each volume is themed and this new edition looks in detail at the Royal Marines and the United States Marine Corps The RM were founded in 1664 but their royal title was only granted to them on 29 April 1802 The USMC traces its roots to the Continental Marines of the American Revolutionary War or American War of Independence when two battalions were formed by Captain Samuel Nicholas after a resolution of the Second Continental Congress on 10 November 1775 Both corps have similar duties then and now and in this volume there are newly researched articles about their common roles in the age of sail The main piece has been written by Major General Julian Thompson and there are leading articles by American and British scholars including Dr Charles P Neimeyer the Director and Chief of Marine Corps History at Marine Corps University Quantico Virginia There is also a unique autobiography by a marine who took part in the battle of Trafalgar the War of 1812 the bombardment of Algiers and the First Ashanti War Other issues are investigated including Victory's true colours in which Andrew Baines Head of Historic Ships at the National Museum of the Royal Navy describes the research which went into revealing how Nelson's flagship looked in 1805 Scholars and students experts and enthusiasts fascinated by the era of the sailing navy will be absorbed by this handsomely illustrated journal **British and Irish Religious Orders in Europe, 1560-1800** Cormac Begadon, James E. Magazine and Historical Chronicle, 1806 England's Empty Throne Paul Strohm, 1998-01-01 The methods employed by the Lancastrian usurpers in their attempts to legitimise their dynasty s hold in the English throne included the reburying of the murdered Richard II the invention of chronicles prophecies and genealogies new methods of trial and punishment the use of spies and the radical redefinition of treason Strohm uses both literary and historical analysis to explore this quest for legitimacy and the importance of symbolic activity to Henry IV and V Text/Events in Early Modern England Sandra Logan, 2018-01-18 Engaging with a range of events historical moments theatrical performances public presentations and courtly intrigues and the texts that record them this book explores representational practice as a component of Elizabethan political culture Considering the inscriptive production of mediated indirect experience as an authorial challenge to the value of the immediate direct experience of events and conversely recognizing the multi valent impact of theatrical performance and performativity as a reinvigoration of the immediate this study traces the emergence of realness as a textual effect and a mode of political intervention This interactive refractive nexus of experience and inscription comprises what Sandra Logan calls the text event The four primary foci of this investigation the 1558 coronation entry the 1575 entertainments at Kenilworth the 1590s dramatizations of the reign of Richard II and the Essex trial of 1601 serve as exempla of four moments in the reign of Elizabeth I which suggest an increasingly complex interaction between events and texts developing in the last half of the sixteenth century Logan argues that in representing England s recent and distant past a wide range of social subjects engaged in a struggle for intellectual credibility and social viability and in the process generated a contingent public sphere within which history framed as a coherent narrative shaped by causal relationships was brought to bear on the concerns of the Elizabethan present and future Assessing how these chronicles short prose histories and historical dramas each made use of the materials and techniques of the others blurring the distinctions between historiography and poetry as well as between past and present Logan considers the conjunctions between the development of new genres and perceptions

about inscription and experience and changing socioeconomic institutions and practices The Oxford Handbook of Holinshed's Chronicles Paulina Kewes, Ian W. torture at Valognes The novel's structure divided into chapters that chronicle de Valois's evolution from calculated manipulator to something altogether more terrifying allows Anderson to explore the machinery of medieval power from multiple angles The early chapters focusing on de Valois's education in the art of manipulation establish the groundwork for what becomes an increasingly dark narrative The pivotal Valognes sequence where de Valois endures torture to protect William serves as a psychological turning point after which the character's remaining humanity is stripped away entirely Anderson's prose is remarkable for its clinical precision mirroring de Valois's own detached perspective Descriptions of violence and torture are presented with an almost documentary like objectivity that makes them all the more disturbing Consider this passage describing de Valois's approach to interrogation Guy watched with mechanical precision as the man's resistance crumbled noting each detail with the same detachment he might bring to reviewing garrison reports This detached style serves to heighten the horror rather than diminish it The historical research underpinning the novel is impressive Anderson demonstrates a deep understanding of Norman political structures Byzantine court intrigue and the complex web of relationships that characterised medieval power politics His attention to detail extends beyond mere historical facts to encompass the psychological realities of medieval life The author's background in management consulting appears to inform his understanding of institutional power dynamics lending credibility to the political machinations he describes The novel's treatment of the Norman Conquest itself offers a fascinating alternative perspective on this pivotal historical event Rather than focusing solely on military aspects Anderson explores the intelligence operations and psychological warfare that preceded and followed the invasion Through de Valois's cold calculations we see how networks of informants carefully cultivated fears and strategic betrayals contributed to Norman success Particularly compelling is the novel's exploration of Byzantine politics through de Valois's later missions to Constantinople Anderson captures the sophisticated complexity of Byzantine court intrigue creating a fascinating contrast with the more direct power politics of Norman society The sections dealing with de Valois's manipulation of Byzantine factions demonstrate Anderson's ability to handle complex political narratives while maintaining narrative tension The supporting cast is well drawn with characters like William the Conqueror Robert Boucher and Solomon ben Isaac serving as effective foils to de Valois's calculating nature William in particular emerges as a complex figure ambitious and ruthless yet possessing a humanity that his spymaster lacks The relationship between William and de Valois forms one of the novel's central tensions exploring themes of loyalty power and the price of ambition Anderson's handling of medieval warfare and espionage feels authentic without becoming bogged down in technical details The siege sequences particularly the fall of Bari demonstrate his ability to balance military action with political intrigue His description of medieval intelligence gathering and network building is particularly convincing showing how personal relationships and careful observation could be weaponised in an age before modern surveillance technology The novel's treatment of family relationships is particularly chilling De Valois's complete emotional detachment

from his wife and children viewing them merely as pieces on a political chessboard serves to emphasise his fundamental inhumanity Anderson refuses to provide easy explanations or redemptive moments for his character maintaining de Valois's psychological consistency throughout the narrative Where the novel particularly excels is in its exploration of medieval power structures and the ways in which violence and fear were institutionalised Anderson shows how systems of control were maintained not just through physical force but through careful manipulation of social relationships and psychological pressure The methods described while specific to their historical context carry uncomfortable resonances with modern systems of control and surveillance The book's final chapters culminating in de Valois's capture and execution in Constantinople provide a fitting end to this dark narrative The blood eagle execution scene is particularly powerful not for its physical violence but for what it represents the ultimate failure of pure calculation in the face of human emotion and vengeance The epilogue which draws parallels between medieval systems of control and modern power structures feels somewhat heavy handed compared to the subtlety of the main narrative However it does serve to emphasise the novel's broader themes about the nature of power and human cruelty The Duke's Shadow represents a significant contribution to historical fiction offering a dark but compelling exploration of medieval power politics through the lens of an unforgettable character Anderson's achievement lies in creating a narrative that works both as a gripping historical thriller and as a deeper meditation on the nature of power loyalty and the capacity for human cruelty The novel raises uncomfortable questions about the nature of loyalty and service the price of power and the thin line between calculated necessity and pure evil Through de Valois Anderson forces us to confront the darker aspects of human nature and the ways in which systems of power can strip away humanity For readers interested in medieval history political intrigue or psychological horror The Duke's Shadow offers a compelling and disturbing reading experience Anderson's work stands out in the historical fiction genre for its unflinching portrayal of medieval realpolitik and its psychological depth While not for the faint hearted it represents historical fiction at its most thoughtful and challenging This first instalment in the Spy Wars Trilogy sets a high bar for the subsequent volumes Anderson has created a work that transcends the usual boundaries of historical fiction offering insights into both medieval politics and human nature that remain relevant to contemporary readers The Duke's Shadow is ultimately a reminder that while the methods of power may change the fundamental dynamics of control fear and manipulation remain disturbingly constant across the centuries

A Haiti Chronicle Daniel Whitman, 2005-01-13

Counselor for Public Affairs at the U S Embassy in Port au Prince in 1999-2001 Daniel Whitman was haunted by the country's people and landscapes its nuanced language and complex and rewarding friendships His friends included neighbors art gallery owners gas station attendants but mostly Haiti's intrepid journalists and broadcasters Unlike others Whitman believed that the three elections of 2000 could advance Haiti's democracy and its development from the bottom rung as poorest nation in the Western Hemisphere He was wrong they did not Local supremacists killed torched and rushed to fraud

while foreigners forgave and even blessed the electoral debacles without posing the resistance even of meaningful public comment However seeds also germinated to make Haiti one day fit for its inventive humor loving and too often betrayed people The effort was kept alive largely by Haiti s gritty journalists going into hiding when necessary for their survival but newly organized in October of 1999 into a tenacious and daring national federation The nation wide Haitian Press Federation advanced against all odds and held eight regional meetings which changed political discourse forever in Haiti The country now enters a post Aristide interlude The failure of one regime does not guarantee success for the next A Haiti Chronicle offers recent context for understanding Haiti s current crisis and opportunity

British West Indian Newspapers and the Abolition of Slavery Andrew Lewis, 2024-06-07 This book is the first overall survey of the British West Indian press in the early nineteenth century a critical period in the history of the region Based on extensive and ground breaking archival research this volume provides an in depth history of early nineteenth century British West Indian newspapers and potted biographies of the journalists who produced them The author examines the economics underpinning newspapers and a political spectrum unique to the West Indian press is also posited Towards one end sat a small group of liberal newspapers that outraged white colonists by arguing for civil and political rights to be extended to so called free coloureds and for the abolition of slavery scattered at various points towards the other end of the spectrum were newspapers still best collectively described as the planter press the traditional term used in the literature Starting from this basic conceptual framework the volume shows how the press landscape in the British Caribbean at this time was more volatile and complex than has been previously thought This volume will be of value to academics undergraduates and postgraduates studying Caribbean and media history and those interested in modern history
