Lucinda Rosenfeld, 2007-12-18 A fresh in more than one sense and honest new voice in fiction is extravagantly displayed in this first novel that candidly dissects modern romance Plagued with weird parents an underdeveloped body and a mind on the verge of self deconstruction Phoebe Fine feels ill equipped for a journey through the hardening chambers of the late twentieth century heart But from fifth grade and Roger Mancuso equal parts baby Brando and court jester through her early adult life with New Media executive Neil Schmertz a babytalker who prefers spooning to sex Phoebe trudges defiantly through guyland armed with a tart tongue and propelled by an insatiable desire to be loved
