- Which Command Element structure will be utilized, i.e., Single Command Command Element or Unified Command – Command Element; and.
- Which Agency will be designated Primary Agency in a Single Command Command Element; or, which Agencies will be designated Primary Agencies in a Unified Command — Command Element.

NYPD will be the Primary Agency (Incident Communitor) at CBRN / HazMat incidents. If NYPD determines there is no actual or suspected criminal activity or terrorism, a Unified Communit will be implemented.

The Operations Section will be a Unified Operations Section based on agency Core Competencies in all circumstances, with NYPD responsible for overall site management, and assessment and investigations for criminal activity or terrorism, and with FDNY responsible for Life Safety Operations (sourch for and rescue injured; and provide pre-hospital emergency medical care and transport; and address immediate life safety hazards to the public) and mass decontamination. For chemical incidents, DEP will make a final assessment of the hazard, adjust or set "hot", "warm" and "cold" zones, and direct all mitigation efforts. For biological or realisological incidents, DOIDHH will make a final assessment of the hazard, adjust or set "hot", "warm" and "cold" zones, and direct all mitigation efforts.
