However, threats arising from the loss and degradation of natural habitats have had no less effect on moths and have endangered many more species. The status and fortunes of many moths are still unknown, but a growing number of success stories such as that of the Black-veined Moth point the way to better practice for the future and to the preservation of this enormous wealth of beauty, diversity and natural history interest.
