cameras the limiting stellar magnitude and image scale of small telescopes can be increased dramatically thus providing results one normally expects from larger instruments Much of this book applies that principle to making interesting and useful astronomical observations I have taken novel approaches to extending the use of small instruments for quantitative observations by applying unique methods for the analysis of digital camera photographs
