NOTIFICATION OF THE INTERBANK RATE TO BE APPLIED ON 2024 JUNE ORDINARY AND ADVANCED LEVEL EXAMINATION FEES PAID IN ZWL

The Zimbabwe School Examinations Council would like to inform its stakeholders, parents/ guardians, and candidates of the Interbank rate which shall apply when making payments for the 2024 June Ordinary and Advanced level Examination Fees in ZWL.

Fees are pegged in USD however they are accepted in the currency which the parents/ guardians are comfortable with. Parents who wish to make payments in USD or Rands are able to do so until the registration closing dates. Those who would like to make payments in ZWL will use the rate communicated below.

Parents/ Guardians who wish to pay registration fees in Zimbabwe Dollar (ZWL) are able to do so during the window of 13 March to 20 March 2024. The interbank rate of 13 March 2024 will be used during this period to ensure that all candidates pay a uniform registration fee.

Global Economic Prospects, June 2015 The World Bank, 2015-06-22 Global growth is expected to be 2.8 percent in 2015 but is expected to pick up to 3.2 percent in 2016. Growth in developing countries and some high income countries is set to disappoint again this year. The prospect of rising borrowing costs will compound the challenges many developing countries are facing as they adapt to an era of low commodity prices. Risks to this outlook remain tilted to the downside. This edition of Global Economic Prospects includes two Special Features that analyze the policy challenges raised by the two transitions in developing countries: the risks associated with the first U.S. central bank interest rate increase since 2006 and the implications of persistently low commodity prices for low income countries. Global Economic Prospects is a World Bank Group Flagship Report that examines global economic developments and prospects with a special focus on developing countries on a semiannual basis in January and June. The January edition includes in depth analyses of topical policy challenges faced by developing countries while the June edition contains shorter analytical pieces.

Legal Protection of Foreign Direct Investment. A Critical Assessment with Focus on South Africa and Zimbabwe Talkmore Chidede, 2016-09 This study undertakes a critical assessment of the legal protection of foreign direct investments (FDI) in South Africa and Zimbabwe by determining their compliance with the international minimum standards, norms and or best practices on the legal protection of FDI by host states. Firstly, the study argues that foreign investment is much needed in South Africa and Zimbabwe to improve economic growth and development, to create jobs and to increase their competitiveness. However, these benefits are not accrued automatically but rather host states need to create an enabling environment to receive such benefits. Thus, host states need to put an investment scheme into operation to guarantee the legal protection of foreign investments. South Africa and Zimbabwe have at large crafted and implemented investment laws and related policies which tend to be hostile towards foreign investments. Therefore, similar investment laws and related policies in both jurisdictions are analysed. This study will also offer recommendations for a legal investment which is not only flexible, friendly and favourable to foreign investment in South Africa and Zimbabwe but also advances their local economic policies.

Regional Economic Outlook, October 2015 International Monetary Fund, 2015-10-27 Growth in sub-Saharan Africa has weakened after more than a decade of solid growth, although this overall outlook masks considerable variation across the region. Some countries have been negatively affected by falling prices of their main commodity exports. Oil exporting countries including Nigeria and Angola have been hit hard by falling revenues and the resulting fiscal adjustments, while middle income countries such as Ghana, South Africa and Zambia are also facing unfavorable conditions. Democracy, Elections, and Constitutionalism in Africa Charles M.
