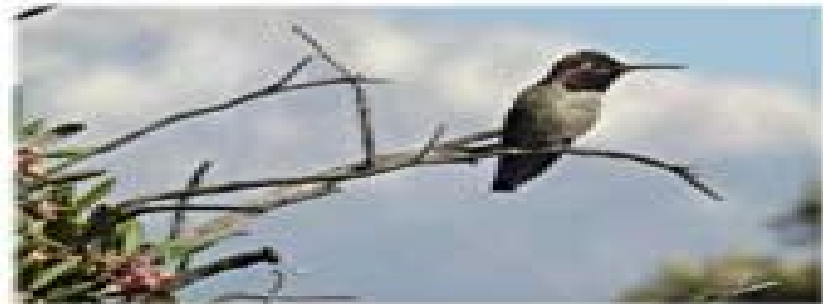

Mahoney, 2015-01-06 100 pages with sixty three different writing activities to guide your students in using similes to describe a person place or thing Each page has an incredible photo taken by me out on local trails to provide a comparison of character or actions a flower a gnarly tree a bunny a squirrel eating a nut a cactus a withered leaf a blue jay a hummingbird a lizard a dragonfly a honeybee a bee mimic fly a monarch caterpillar tiny aphids a shield bug a snail shell a mushroom or a water drop a wild mountain goat a pine cone a bench two hawks a dark tunnel two crisscrossing trees a creek a seed pod a vine wrapped around a branch a mother spider protecting her egg sac and so much more In the first section students create their own similes Each page has a sample simile based on one of my photos like these as nervous as a blue jay on a branch as watchful as a lizard on a log as pushy as a mushroom after a storm as noisy as a hungry woodpecker in the spring as crowded as a stalk full of aphids as sharp as the spines on a cactus as wrinkly as an old leaf as empty as a snail s old shell as slow as a shield bug trying to get away and more Students will learn to create NEW similes not repeat the trite and weak similes of others In the second section students write a story based on a photo and its prompt inserting three new similes into the story Each photo has a prompt like a rabbit that was scared of the rain a flower that wanted to be a tree a snail that ran away a cactus that didn t want to hurt others a lonely tree that missed its leaves a bench that didn t like to be sat on a mountain goat that liked to fight a fish trapped in a cold creek two trees that argued every day and more Perfect for whole class instruction or a literacy center Use it for your Gifted students or early finishers Or send it with them for homework Common Core Standards ELA 4 L 5b and 5 L 5a and 5 RL 4
