- Strongly suggest (adverb - verb pattern) = insistent eg of how a good strong verb is better than an adverb and verb pattern.
- Author's insistence that (contention) is met with verb (eg derision) from the reader as ... (reason why contention is not taken seriously)

Maliciously suggest= insinuate

Quote ... Acts as an insinuation against xxxx, in that the reader is invited to see (person portrayed) as bxbxbxx
