

25. **C**

The oxide of J functions as a catalyst in the decomposition of hydrogen peroxide. Hence, J is most likely a transition metal. The answer is C, in which J is manganese.

26. **A**

Option A is not relevant in the construction of aircraft. Magnalium is used because of its low density, high strength and resistance to corrosion.

27. **B**

Group I metals are very reactive and form very stable ores. Hence, electrolysis must be used on its molten ore in order to provide sufficient energy to separate the ions in order to extract rubidium.

28. **C**

Carbon dioxide cannot be further oxidized because the oxidation state of carbon is already +4. Carbon monoxide (oxidation state of carbon in CO is +2) can be further oxidized to carbon dioxide while unburnt petrol gases can be further oxidized to carbon dioxide as well.

29. **A**

Sulfuric acid reacts with solid calcium carbonate to form calcium sulfate which is insoluble in water. If a large lump of calcium carbonate is used, a layer of insoluble calcium sulfate is formed quickly and this prevents the sulfuric acid from coming into contact with calcium carbonate. Hence, the reaction will soon stop.

30. **C**

Nitrogen oxide is reduced to form nitrogen gas in the catalytic converter. Option A is wrong because carbon monoxide is oxidized to form carbon dioxide (not reduction). Nitrogen dioxide and sulfur dioxide are acidic gases. The reaction with calcium carbonate is not a redox reaction.
