Gordon Childe, 2014-10-24 This volume originally published in 1935 sought to reveal the significance of Scottish prehistory for the development of understanding of European prehistory Written at a time of rapid accumulation of new relics and monuments and the insights from them Professor Childe presented some important new data and made tentative conclusions for the future results from these finds After an introduction to the geography of Scotland the book looks at evidence from cairns tombs and stone circles and then addresses chronologically the evidence from Early Bronze Age to Late and onto the Iron Age with a chapter devoted to forts towns and castles It ends with a discussion of what happened in the Dark Ages and addresses questions about the Celts and the Picts and the diversity of the peoples in Scotland

**Scotland Before the Scots** V Gordon Childe, 2023-08-31 Originally published in 1946 this book presents in what can arguably be described as an unusual way a slice of Scottish social life by applying to prehistory the principles of Marxism as practised by Soviet scholars of Russian prehistory Using archaeological evidence the author distinguishes 6 stages from the earliest definable groups of immigrants to the Iron Age There are 10 appendices devoted to the typology and classification of tombs pottery implements and fortifications
