Guidelines for Evaluating Water in Pit Slope Stability is a comprehensive account of the hydrogeological procedures that should be followed when performing open pit slope stability design studies. Created as an outcome of the Large Open Pit LOP project, an international research and technology transfer project on the stability of rock slopes in open pit mines, this book expands on the hydrogeological model chapter in the LOP project's previous book Guidelines for Open Pit Slope Design. The results of a questionnaire indicate that most hydraulic engineers are not familiar with the procedures used to develop standards or with existing national or international standards. However, responses to the questionnaire show that hydraulic engineers welcome guides or standards as long as some flexibility to use engineering judgment for site-specific conditions is allowed. The report recommends that guidelines or consensus standards be developed in the following areas: application of one-dimensional surface water computer programs of the HEC-2 type; prediction of scour at bridge piers; design of pump intakes and sumps; and calculations of friction and form losses in closed conduits. Guidelines for Open Pit Slope Design in Weak Rocks Derek Martin, Peter Stacey, 2018-01-10 Weak rocks encountered in open pit mines cover a wide variety of materials with properties ranging between soil and rock As such they can provide a significant challenge for the slope designer For these materials the mass strength can be the primary control in the design of the pit slopes although structures can also play an important role Because of the typically weak nature of the materials groundwater and surface water can also have a controlling influence on stability *Guidelines for Open Pit Slope Design in Weak Rocks* is a companion to *Guidelines for Open Pit Slope Design* which was published in 2009 and dealt primarily with strong rocks Both books were commissioned under the Large Open Pit LOP project which is sponsored by major mining companies These books provide summaries of the current state of practice for the design implementation and assessment of slopes in open pits with a view to meeting the requirements of safety as well as the recovery of anticipated ore reserves This book which follows the general cycle of the slope design process for open pits contains 12 chapters These chapters were compiled and written by industry experts and contain a large number of case histories The initial chapters address field data collection the critical aspects of determining the strength of weak rocks the role of groundwater in weak rock slope stability and slope design considerations which can differ somewhat from those applied to strong rock The subsequent chapters address the principal weak rock types that are encountered in open pit mines including cemented colluvial sediments weak sedimentary mudstone rocks soft coals and chalk weak limestone saprolite soft iron ores and other leached rocks and hydrothermally altered rocks A final chapter deals with design implementation aspects including mine planning monitoring surface water control and closure of weak rock slopes As with the other books in this

series Guidelines for Open Pit Slope Design in Weak Rocks provides guidance to practitioners involved in the design and implementation of open pit slopes particularly geotechnical engineers mining engineers geologists and other personnel working at operating mines
