



COMMUNIQUÉ 23 MARS TRACTAGE JOP

JOP : zone de non-droit syndical !

Samedi 23 mars, dans le cadre de la journée de formation des volontaires des Jeux Olympiques et Paralympiques (JOP) à l'Arena de la Défense, des militant-es de nos organisations ont distribué un tract informant les participant-es de l'état du droit du travail quant à leurs conditions d'intervention aux JOP : le travail fourni va s'effectuer dans des conditions de subordination, y compris pour certain-es au bénéfice d'une société commerciale, il devrait donc relever du salariat et des droits qui y sont attachés .

Alors qu'une quinzaine de militant-es, signalé-es par des chasubles, distribuait tranquillement les informations syndicales à l'extérieur du périmètre de l'événement, iels ont été approché-es au bout de vingt minutes de tractage par différents services de police. Les policier-ères ont d'abord pris leurs informations puis les ont interpellé-es de nouveau pour leur demander de partir et d'enlever leurs chasubles. Lors de cette interpellation, nos militant-es ont fait l'objet d'un contrôle d'identité et leurs sacs ont été fouillés sans qu'aucun motif légitime ne soit invoqué. Des tracts ont été saisis. Certain-es policier-ères ont intimidé les militant-es, notamment en menaçant de les emmener au commissariat et de poursuites judiciaires. L'un des policiers s'est vanté de ne « pas avoir peur de faire des erreurs judiciaires » et de « s'en foutre de la loi, on verra devant le juge ».

Les volontaires ont par ailleurs réagi avec bienveillance à la diffusion de nos tracts, certain-es s'arrêtant pour discuter avec nous et nous remerciant de notre présence. Nous dénonçons la démesure du dispositif de sécurité et le comportement des policier-ères contre une action d'information sur les droits des « bénévoles ».

Le gouvernement prétend que les JOP sont une fête populaire mais s'en sert pour bafouer nos droits fondamentaux, à commencer par celui de la libre expression pourtant garantie constitutionnellement. Il est inadmissible que les organisations syndicales, associatives ou politiques soient intimidées et ne puissent exercer leur droit à communiquer et informer dans l'espace public.

Nowhere Countries: Exclusion of Non-Citizens from Rights through Extra-Territoriality at Home Pauline Maillet, 2019-12-09 In *Nowhere Countries Exclusion of Non Citizens from Rights through Extra Territoriality at Home* Pauline Maillet offers a new theoretical framework to understand the mechanisms by which non citizens are excluded from the rights attached to sovereign territory when arriving at states borders Initiated in Charles de Gaulle airport the analysis encompasses similar cases in countries other than France This interdisciplinary study traces how some liberal democracies create spaces construed as extra territorial on their own soil to circumvent obligations owed to sea or airborne asylum seekers under the Refugee Convention and its Protocol How do states make their territory vanish to prevent asylum seekers arrival Using a combination of legal analysis and ethnography this book identifies the legal techniques enforcement practices and mental landscapes that have sustained nowhere countries

African Human Rights Yearbook / Annuaire africain des droits de l'homme 3 (2019), 2019-01-01 About the publication The African Charter on the Rights and Welfare of the Child African Children's Rights Charter is the continental instrument for protecting and promoting the rights and welfare of the Child The Children's Charter adopted in 1990 forms part of the salient features of the African human rights system complementing the parent human rights instrument the African Charter on Human and Peoples Rights African Charter To give meaning and effect to its provisions the African Children's Rights Charter in article 34 establishes an organ namely the African Committee of Experts on the Rights and Welfare of the Child African Children's Rights Committee or Committee to monitor implementation by member states to advocate for children's rights and to hold state parties accountable to their obligations as state parties Working collaboratively on the continent's human rights system the organs comprising the

The International Legal System in Quest of Equity and Universality Laurence Boisson de

Chazournes, Vera Gowlland-Debbas, 2021-10-18 Georges Abi Saab began his writing and teaching at a time when the process of decolonization and thereafter the quest for emancipation began to make its far reaching impact on the international scene producing significant changes in the international environment both quantitatively in increasing the number of nation States and qualitatively in changing patterns of interests and claims This was bound to result in new pressures on the international legal system itself and in a questioning of the traditional Eurocentric content of international law In his work and teaching Professor Abi Saab viewed the dynamics of international law as a function of two driving forces the emergence of the third world and the sense of injustice In his view the first driving force the emergence of the third world raised the problem of exclusion exclusion from participation in the elaboration of international law and the decision making process and exclusion as beneficiaries of the resulting rules of international law At the same time this new force introduced diversity into the international scene reflecting the richness of the international community in its different facets This process remains relevant today reflecting the contemporary problem of exclusion of new actors as well as their quest for participation The second driving force the sense of injustice posed a teleological problem for him that of defining community values in order that they capture the different facets of justice whether formal or distributive So long as there is no effective organic structure international law in his view will continue to remain effectiveness oriented reflecting rather than impacting on the structures of power Nevertheless it is undeniable that there is an on going process of development of community values and interests as Georges Abi Saab wrote with reference to international crimes law like all social phenomena is a continuous unfolding a continuous process of elaboration He has also considered that the dynamics of the international legal process itself can be captured from the perspective of international organizations as vehicles for change in the international system From his early writings Georges Abi Saab approached the United Nations Charter as a blueprint both normative and institutional for a certain type of international society International institutions with all their imperfections continue for him to be the means of

realization of the law of cooperation which lies at the heart of his concept of the international system The themes selected for this volume in honour of Professor Georges Abi Saab are intended to reflect his unique and pioneering contribution to the field of international law The contributors are drawn from what he has always considered to be his large family of former students in his forty years of teaching Georges Abi Saab has acted as mentor to generations of students from all over the world who have benefited from his vision insights originality and creative and stimulating use of language The contributors also include colleagues and friends who share a similar vision of the international legal system **Locally Led**
