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COVID-19 Lockdowns and the Urban Poor in Harare, Zimbabwe Johannes Itai Bhanye, Fortune Mangara, Abraham R. Matamanda, Lameck Kachena, 2023-12-09 This book focuses on the socio economic impacts of the COVID 19 pandemic and associated lockdowns on the welfare of the urban poor in the city of Harare Zimbabwe. The authors look through the lenses of the urban health penalty, the right to the city, complexity theory and distributive justice theory. These four theories help situate the COVID 19 pandemic and its impacts on the urban poor in the theoretical foundations that raise issues of how the poor are affected by disease health pandemics due to their living conditions. Uniquely, the authors use remote ethnography tools such as rich texts, video diaries and photo uploads to provide evidence-based stories of how COVID 19 mobility restrictions have affected poor urbanites in Harare. The book concludes that the COVID 19 pandemic mandatory lockdowns have deepened social and spatial inequality among the urban poor, threatening their right to the city. The socio economic impacts can upsurge poverty, increase unemployment and the risks of hunger and food insecurity, reinforce existing inequalities and break social harmony in the cities even past the COVID 19 pandemic period. These socioeconomic impacts must be considered to make just cities for all from a right to the city perspective. The authors recommend that mandatory COVID 19 lockdowns should not only be treated as a law and order operation but as a medical intervention to stem the spread of the virus, backed by measures to safeguard the livelihoods of the urban poor while also protecting the economy. This means governments should provide social safety nets to informal sector operators whose income-generating activities are affected the most during the time of emergencies like COVID 19. Planners and policymakers should re-envision pandemic resilient cities that are just, equitable, resilient and sustainable.

Military Assistance on Request and the Use of Force Erika De Wet, 2020-03-26 In countries such as Syria, Iraq, South Sudan and Yemen, internationally recognized governments embroiled in protracted armed conflicts and with very little control over their territory have requested direct military assistance from other states. These requests are often accepted by the other states despite the circumvention of the United Nations Security Council and extensive violation of international humanitarian law and human rights. In this book, Erika De Wet examines the authority entitled to extend a request for or consent to direct military assistance as well as the type of situations during which such assistance may be requested, notably whether it may be requested during a civil war. Ultimately, De Wet addresses the question of if and to what extent the proliferation of military assistance on the request of a recognized government is changing the rules in international law applying to the use of force.

Paramilitary Groups and the State under Globalization Jasmin Hristov, Jeb Sprague, Aaron Tauss, 2021-12-30 This book examines the phenomenon of paramilitarism across Latin America and the Caribbean, Eastern Europe, Africa and Asia, offering a nuanced perspective while identifying key patterns in the way paramilitary violence is implicated in processes of capital accumulation, state building and the reproduction of social power. Paramilitary violence, a key modality of coercion in the era of globalization, has been pursued

The Wealth of (Some) Nations Zak Cope, 2019-03-20 In this provocative new study Zak Cope makes the case that capitalism is empirically inseparable from imperialism historically and today Using a rigorous political economic framework he lays bare the vast ongoing transfer of wealth from the poorest to the richest countries through the mechanisms of monopoly rent unequal exchange and colonial tribute The result is a polarised international class structure with a relatively rich Global North and an impoverished exploited Global South Cope makes the controversial claim that it is because of these conditions that workers in rich countries benefit from higher incomes and welfare systems with public health education pensions and social security As a result the internationalism of populations in the Global North is weakened and transnational solidarity is compromised The only way forward Cope argues is through a renewed anti imperialist politics rooted in a firm commitment to a radical labour internationalism
