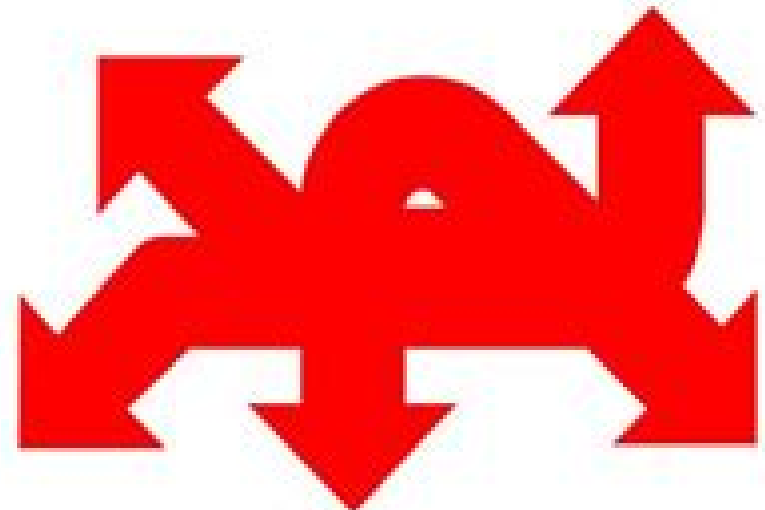


Automatic Stabilizers
