Social Contract (Thomas Hobbes & Jean-Jacques Rousseau)	This is an agreement between people and the government about what they both provide to each other.
Popular Sovereignty (Jean-Jacques Rousseau)	The idea of the government obtains the consent of people and expresses through elected representatives.
Republicanism (Baron de Montesquieu)	This type of government gets limited with the type of elected representatives.

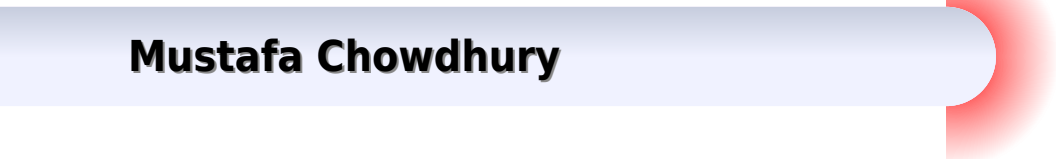
