Memorials of Harriet Martineau by Maria Weston Chapman Deborah Anna Logan, 2015-11-25 Memorials of Harriet Martineau by Maria Weston Chapman was published in 1877 as volume three of Harriet Martineau s Autobiography While the triple decker was a popular format of the era the configuration of a two volume autobiography authored by one and a one volume biography written by another is unusual Indeed the work s publishing history reveals that in reissues of the Autobiography the Memorials volume was not reproduced while some might claim that the problem is with the editor
