Elicit from students. According to the video, what was the Great Awakening? What was appealing about the religious messages that were spreading in the early 1700s?

The first thing we want to do is source the document to see what I can find about the author's perspective. I see that this was written in 1793, over 50 years after the Great Awakening, so I'm not sure how reliable this is Maybe Franklin's memory of hearing Whitefield differs from what actually happened. I know that memory is often inaccurate. I's hard to predict what Franklin will say about Whitefield: on the one hand, they're friends, so he probably won't say bed things. On the other hand, I know that Ben Franklin really believed in Enlightenment ideas and reason, so I don't think he would have bought into the whole revival espect of the Great Awakening, I don't really know what to predict at this point.
