

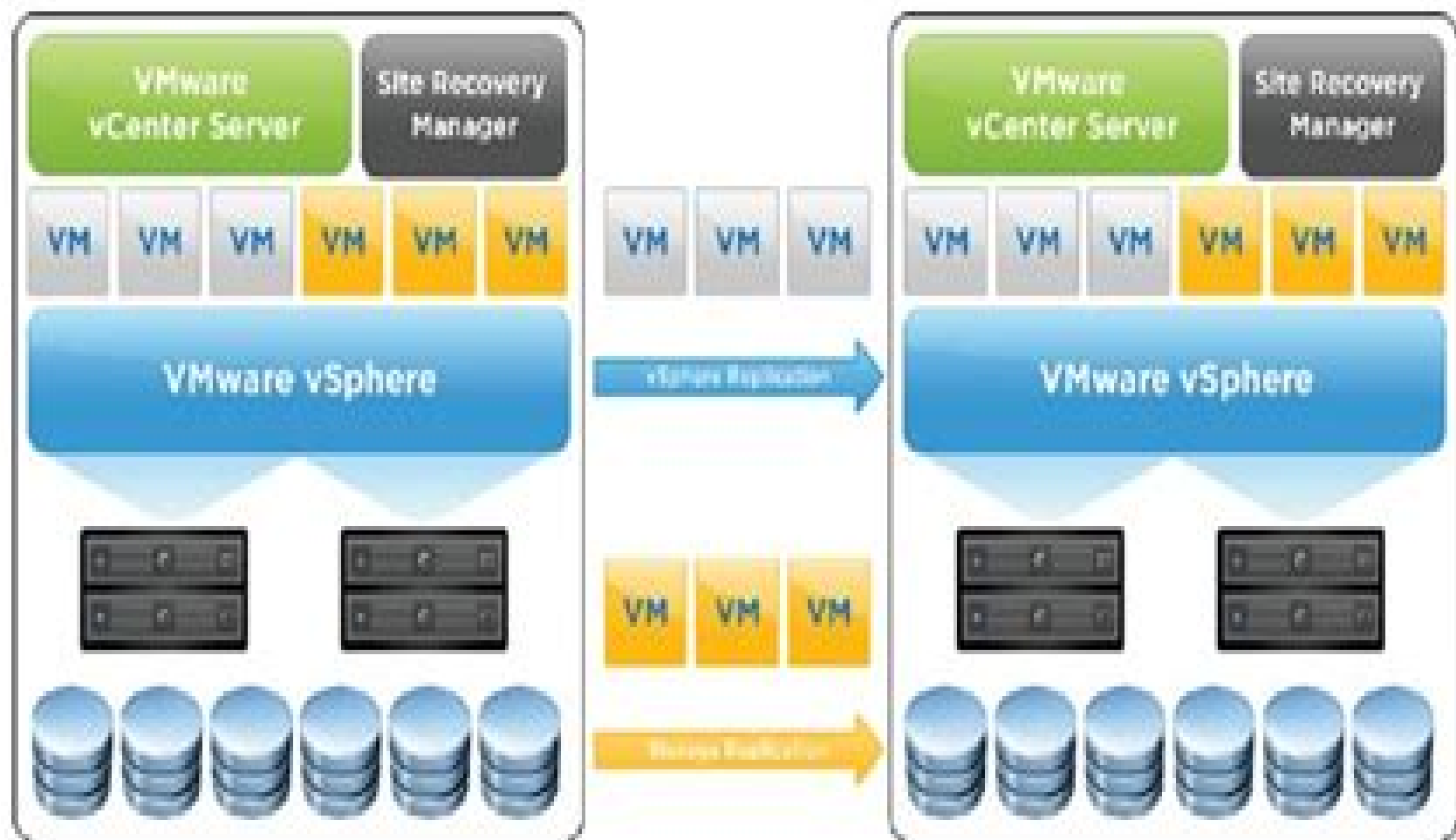


Figure 1. SRM Architecture
