

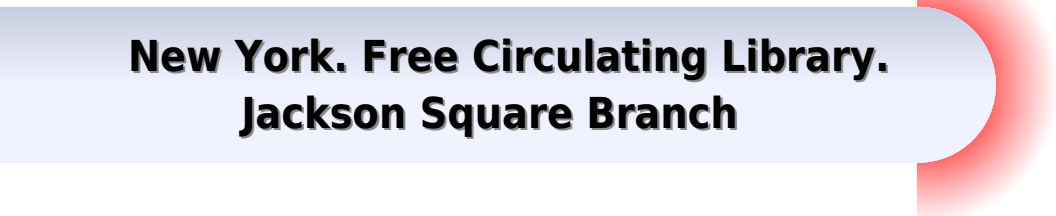
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Reading Children's Literature: A Critical Introduction - Second Edition Carrie Hintz, Eric L. Tribunella, 2019-03-28

Hamel, the Obeah Man is set against the backdrop of early nineteenth-century Jamaica and tells the story of a slave rebellion planned in the ruins of a plantation. Though the novel is sympathetic to white slaveholders and hostile to anti-slavery missionaries, it presents a complex picture of the culture and resistance of the island's black majority. Hamel, the spiritual leader of the rebels, becomes more and more central to the story and is a surprisingly powerful and ultimately ambiguous figure. This Broadview Edition includes a new foreword by Kamau Brathwaite as well as a critical introduction and appendices. The extensive appendices include contemporary reviews of the novel, other authors' and travellers' descriptions of Jamaica, and historical documents related to slave insurrections and the debate over slavery.

Nabokov's Women: The Silent Sisterhood of Textual Nomads is the first book-length study to focus on Nabokov's relationship with his heroines. Essays by distinguished Nabokov scholars explore the multilayered and nomadic nature of Nabokov's women: their voice and voicelessness, their absentness, the paradigm of power and sacrifice within which they are situated, the paradox of their unattainability, their complex relationship with textual borders, the travel narrative with the author himself. By design, Nabokov's woman is often assigned a short-term tourist visa with a firm expiration date. Her departure is facilitated by death or involuntary absence, which watermarks her into the male protagonist's narrative, granting him an artistic release or a gift of self-understanding. When she leaves the stage, her portrait remains ambiguous. She can be powerfully enigmatic but not self-actualized enough to be dynamic, or for even where the terms of her existence are deeply considered, or her image beheld reverently, her recognition seems to be limited to the Works Cited register of the male narrator's personal life. As a result, Nabokov's texts often feature a nomadic woman who seems to live without a narratorial homeland, papers of her own, or storytelling privileges. This volume explores the residency status of Nabokov's silent nomads: his fleeting lovers, witches, muses, mermaids, and nymphets. As Nabokov scholars analyze the power dynamic of the writer's narrative of male desire, they ponder: are these female characters directionless wanderers or covert operatives in the terrain of Nabokov's text? Whereas each essay addresses a different aspect of Nabokov's artistic relationship with the feminine, together they explore

The Bilingual Text Jan Walsh Hokenson, Marcella Munson, 2014-06-03 Bilingual texts have been left outside the mainstream of both translation theory and literary history Yet the tradition of the bilingual writer moving between different sign systems and audiences to create a text in two languages is a rich and venerable one going back at least to the Middle Ages The self translated bilingual text was commonplace in the multilingual world of medieval and early modern Europe frequently bridging Latin and the vernaculars While self translation persisted among cultured elites it diminished during the consolidation of the nation states in the long era of nationalistic monolingualism only to resurge in the postcolonial era The Bilingual Text makes a first step toward providing the fields of translation studies and comparative literature with a comprehensive account of literary self translation in the West It tracks the shifting paradigms of bilinguality across the centuries and addresses the urgent questions that the bilingual text raises for translation theorists today Is each part of the bilingual text a separate original creation or is each incomplete without the other Is self translation a unique genre Can either version be split off into a single language or literary tradition How can two linguistic versions of a text be fitted into standard models of foreign and domestic texts and cultures Because such texts defeat standard categories of analysis The Bilingual Text reverses the usual critical gaze highlighting not dissimilarities but continuities across versions allowing for dissimilarities within orders of correspondence and englobing the literary as well as linguistic and cultural dimensions of the text Emphasizing the arcs of historical change in concepts of language and translation that inform each case study The Bilingual Text examines the perdurance of this phenomenon in Western societies and literatures

Monstrous Motherhood Marilyn Francus, 2013-01-01 Spectral and monstrous mothers populate the cultural

Fairy tales often said to be timeless and fundamentally oral have a long written history However argues Elizabeth Wanning Harries in this provocative book a vital part of this history has fallen by the wayside The short subtly didactic fairy tales of Charles Perrault and the Grimms have determined our notions about what fairy tales should be like Harries argues that alongside these compact tales there exists another complex tradition tales written in France by the conteuses storytelling women in the 1690s and the late twentieth century tales by women writers that derive in part from this centuries old tradition Grounded firmly in social history and set in lucid prose *Twice upon a Time* refocuses the lens through which we look at fairy tales The conteuses saw their tales as amusements for sophisticated adults in the salon not for children Self referential frequently parodic and set in elaborate frames their works often criticize the social expectations that determined the lives of women at the court of Louis XIV After examining the evolution of the Anglo American fairy tale and its place in this variegated history Harries devotes the rest of her book to recent women writers A S Byatt Anne Sexton Angela Carter and Emma Donoghue among them who have returned to fairy tale motifs so as to challenge modern day gender expectations Late twentieth century tales like the conteuses force us to rethink our conception of fairy tales and of their history
