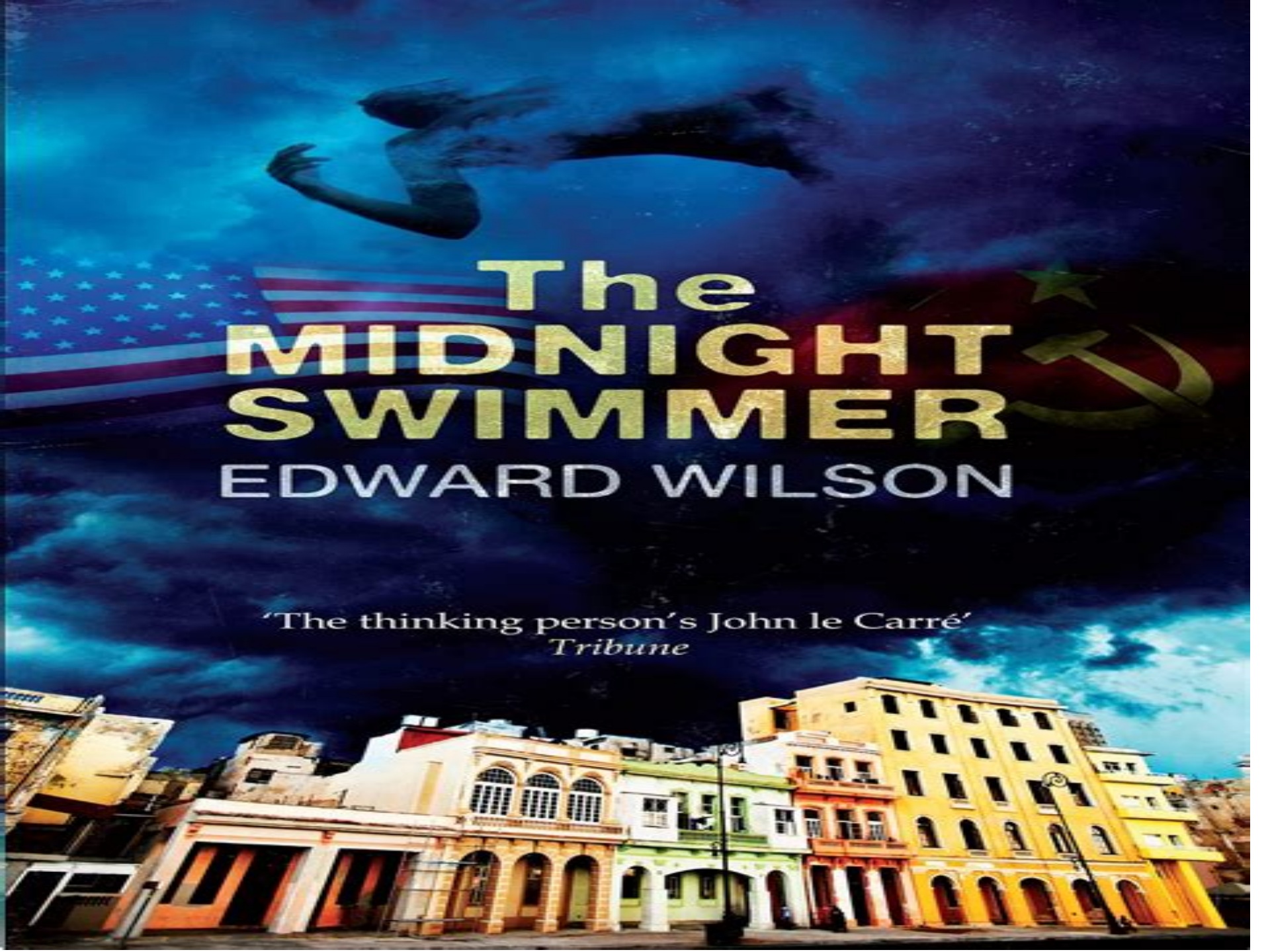

master narratives but also to its privileging of those marginal and at times ignored areas of history. The fourteen works of Canadian fiction considered demonstrate a doubled impulse which at first glance seems contradictory. On the one hand they go about demythologizing in the Barthesian sense various elements of historical discourse exposing its authority as not simply a natural given but as a construct. This includes the fact that the view of history portrayed in the fiction has been either underrepresented or suppressed by official historiography. On the other hand the history is then re-mythologized in that it becomes part of a pre-existing myth; its mythic elements are foregrounded and myth and magic are woven into the narrative or it is portrayed as extraordinary in some way. The result is an empowering of these histories for the future; they are made larger than life and unforgettable.
